EXCERPTS FROM THE RULES OF THE KANSAS AMERICAN LEGION BOWLING ASSOCIATION

- All participants of the American Legion Bowling Association shall be bowlers [male or female] with current American Legion cards and USBC cards. Also SAL members over the age of 18 are eligible to bowl in this tournament, USBC and non-USBC members. Eligible non-league bowlers can qualify for high score recognition at their option by paying a \$18 fee for which the Congress will issue an affiliate membership card.
- 2. The annual bowling tournament of the Kansas American Legion Bowling Association shall include competition in the five-person Team, Doubles, Singles, and All-Events. <u>Contestants entering Doubles must also enter Singles and vice-versa on the same entry sheet.</u> Paid All-Events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all three events, and the transfer is made by the Tournament Director or <u>Assistant(s)</u> prior to the substitute's participation in the event.
- 3. Handicap is based on 90% of 220. Entrants will use their highest USBC or YABA-sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2016-2017 or the 2015-2016 season. If the current 21-game average as of December 1, 2017 is 10 or more pins above the current season average, the current average must be used. If there is no average from the 2016-2017 season, the highest USBC or YABA-sanctioned average must be used, 21 games or more, as of December 21, 2017. Averages established in sanctioned leagues which start their seasons after March 15 for the summer season shall be accepted as official, provided the bowler does not have an acceptable regular season average. Bowlers may enter the tournament with a 175 average if no average has been set for the previous 2 years. If a tournament average from the last 2 years (18 games) is higher than 175, a tournament average will be used.
- Five-person Teams and Doubles will bowl in the order they are entered on the entry blank.
- In the event of mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the contestants affected shall be moved to the next available pair of lanes.
- Individuals will not be permitted to enter more than once in Doubles and Singles
 events. In case of emergency, a host bowler who has previously participated in the
 tournament may bowl with an out-of-town bowler in the Doubles event, only with
 the approval of the Tournament Director.
- All entry fees must be paid in full and must accompany the entry blank. Make remittances payable to the American Legion Bowling Association. No entry fees will be refunded.

- All entrants' first and last names must be listed; do not list nicknames.
 PENALTIES: Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled with zero being given for each frame missed. Use of an ineligible player or reporting an incorrect average will nullify all claims for any prize or award.
- 9. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his team captain, or others. <u>Failure to use</u> the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average, or the base prize winnings of the submitted average is lower than the actual average, or the base prize winnings of the submitted average is higher.
- Protests of errors in scoring or calculations must be made in writing to the Tournament Management within 24 hours after bowling, or the scores will stand as scored.
- 11. Rule 319-A (10 pin rule) effective date is December 1, 2017.
- USBC rule 319-D (report winnings of #300 or more in previous tournaments in past year).
- 13. Average adjustment USBC rule 319-E.
- 14. Rule 319-A-3 (reporting of incorrect average provision).
- 15. MULTIPLE-TEAM ENTRY All bowlers may bowl the Team event twice. They must change two bowlers to bowl the second time. They must enter the second time before entries close. They may cash twice. <u>The high Team event counts for the All-Events score.</u>
- 16. Check-in time is a half hour before the squad time.
- 17. Advance reservations may be made for next year's tournament to be held in Manhattan 2019. with the reservation deadline for entry fees being two weeks prior to the original tournament deadline. For all others not requesting advance reservations, the deadline will remain the same as last year.
- All prize checks must be cashed within 90 days.
